Volunteers will receive training from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., and then will see clients for one (1) hours appointments starting at 10:30 a.m. and ending at 3:30 p.m.

The Wills for Heroes Foundation is a national non-profit organization that provides free wills, advance directives and powers of attorney to first responders, including police officers, firefighters, paramedics, corrections and probation officers. The foundation was started in response to the tragic events of 9/11, and is administered nationwide by local affiliate programs. This particular event aims to assist veterans in need of simple estate planning. At this day-long event, volunteer attorneys meet with veterans and use HotDocs software donated by LexisNexis to draft the documents, which are then signed, witnessed and notarized at the event.
