Student Conservation Association (SCA) Veterans Fire Corps is comprised of post-9/11-era US Military Veterans receiving essential training, credentials and experience to competitively pursue wildland fire and/or forestry careers. In this internship members will serve in teams of five with an experienced SCA Project Leader.

Training Provided:

- Two weeks of field based training
- Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior
- Introduction to Incident Command System
- Standards for Survival
- Human Factors on the Fireline
- Introduction to the National Incident Management System
- Wildland Fire Chainsaw Certification
- Basic Wildlife Firefighter and Red Card Certification
- Wilderness First Aid and CPR
- S190 Certification

Participate in Projects like:

- Prescribed burns
- Fuels Reduction
- Fire effects monitoring
- Educational Outreach
- Pre-fire preparation of burn units

Internship Details:

- Teams will consist of five members with one SCA project leader
- 4 days on 3 days off, 40 hours a week
- Free housing and field-based meals
